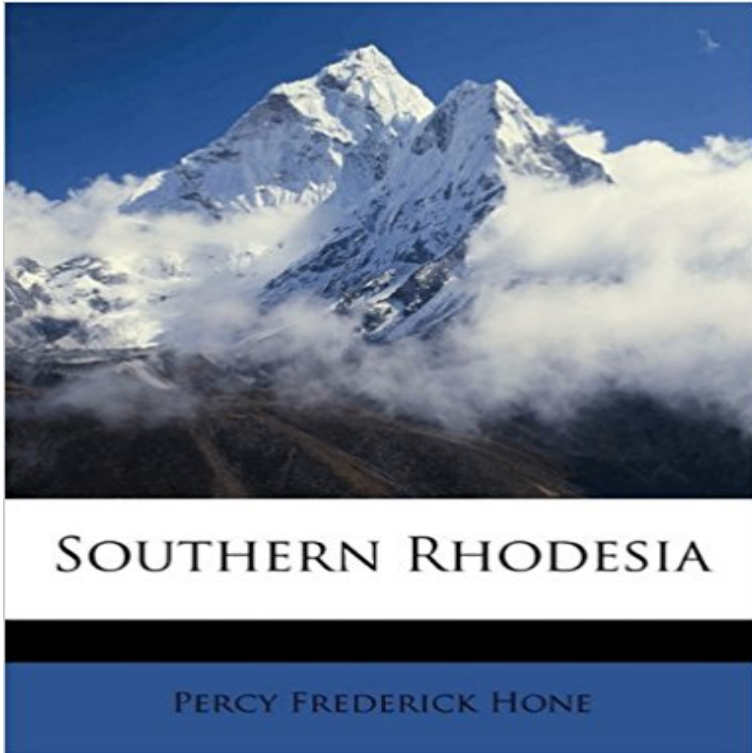


Southern Rhodesia
