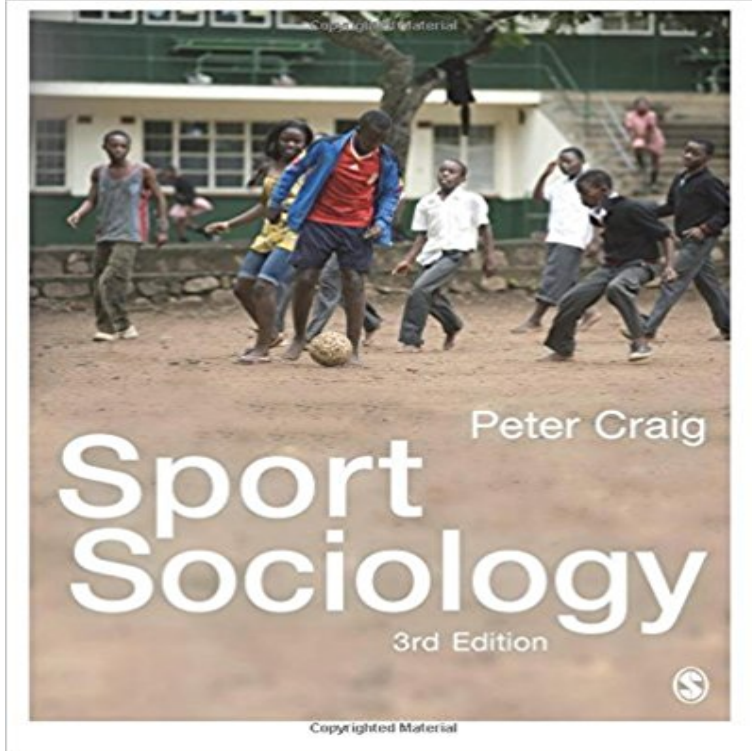


## Sport Sociology (Active Learning in Sport Series)
