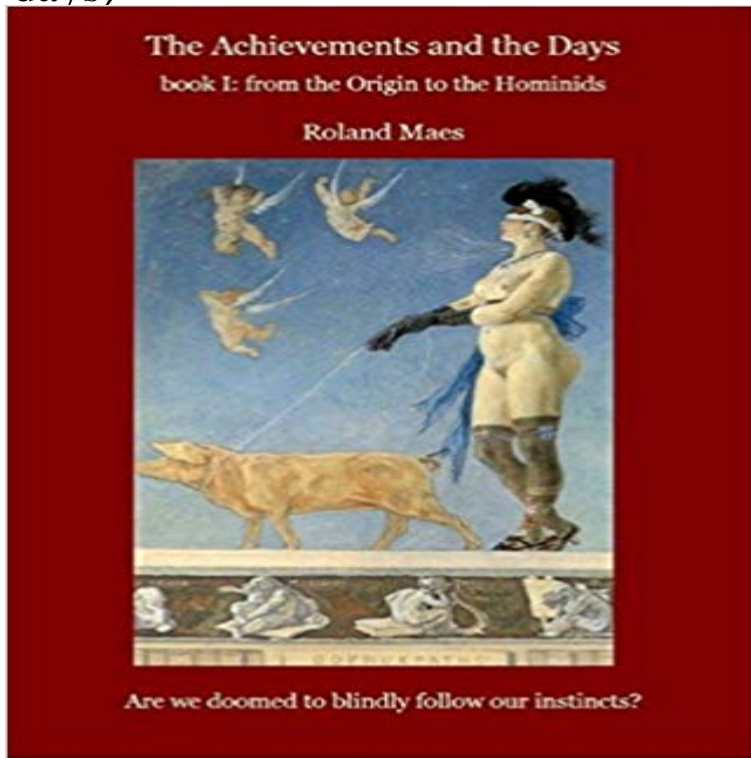


Book 1. From the Origin to the Hominids (The Achievements and the days)
