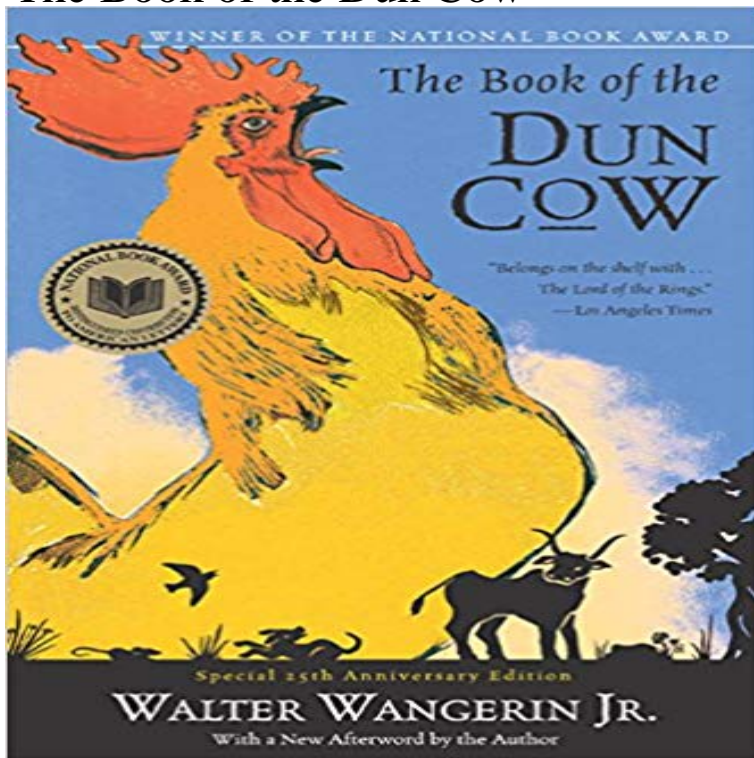


The Book of the Dun Cow
