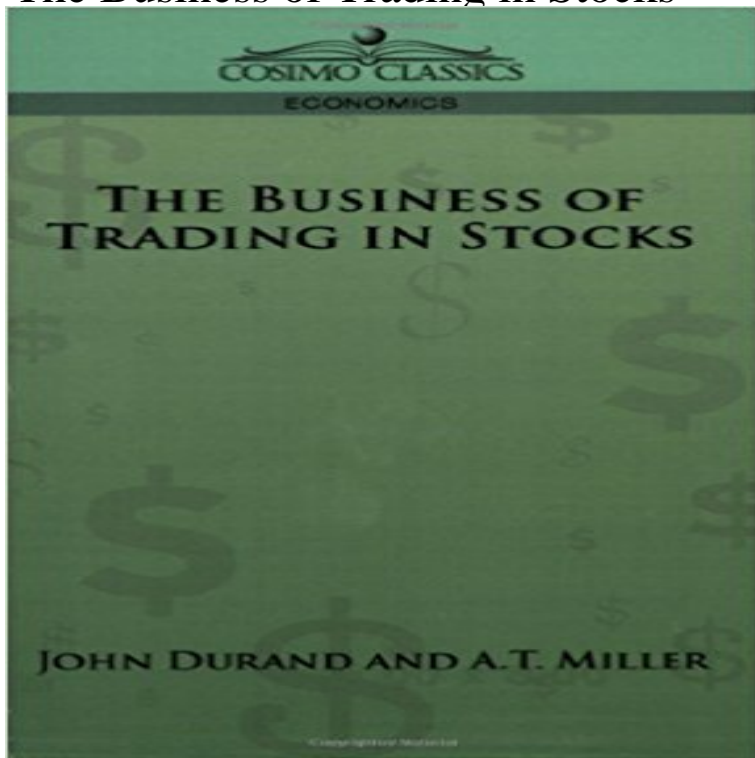


The Business of Trading in Stocks
