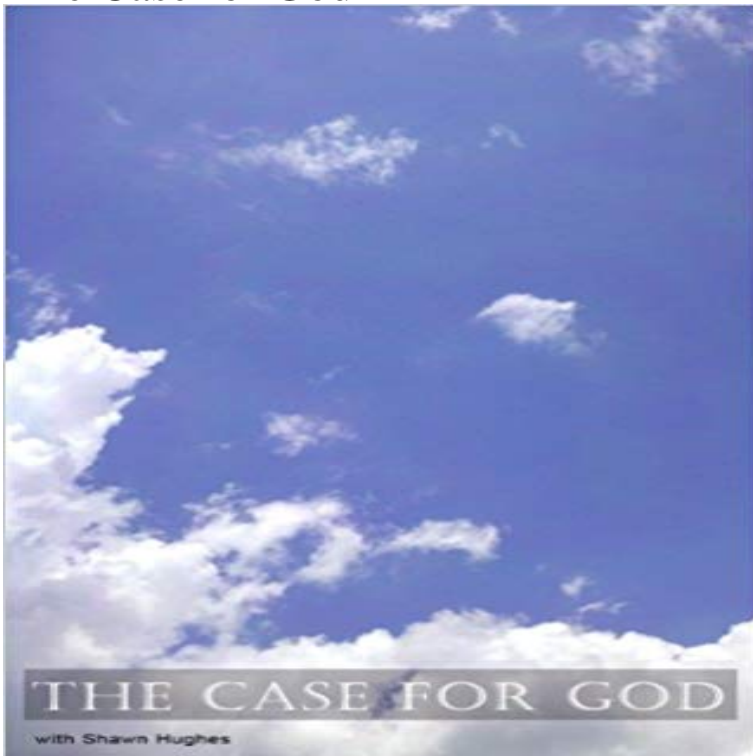


The Case for God
