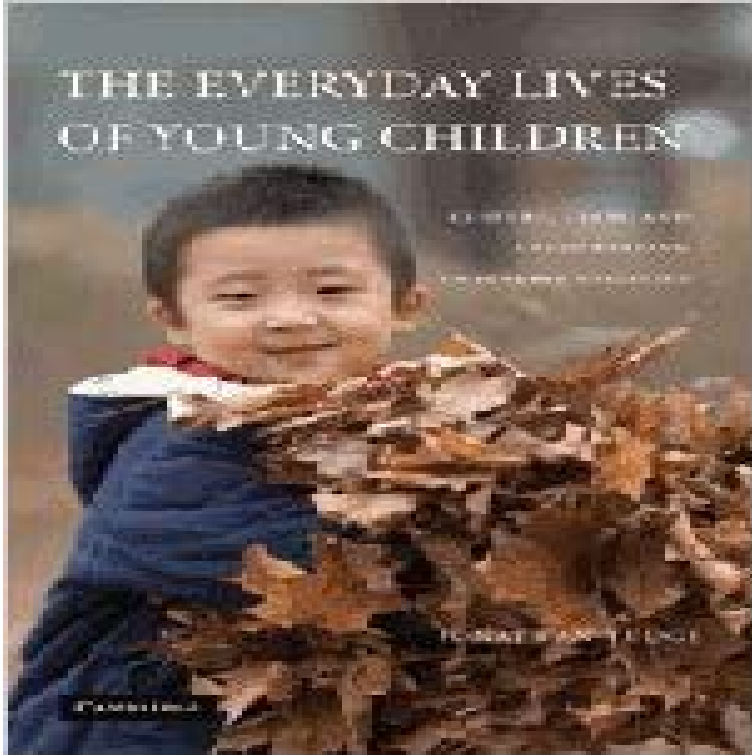


# The Everyday Lives of Young Children: Culture, Class, and Child Rearing in Diverse Societies
