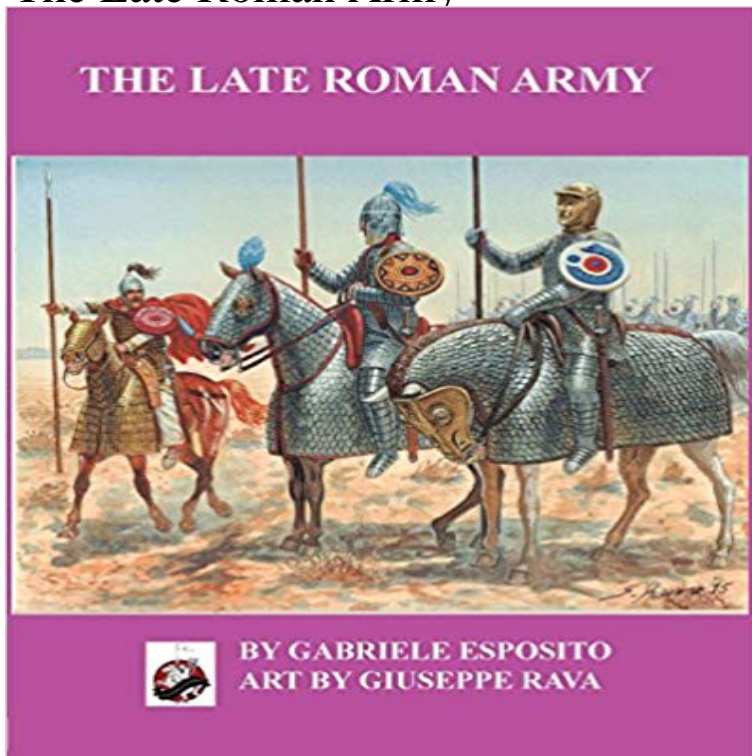


## The Late Roman Army
