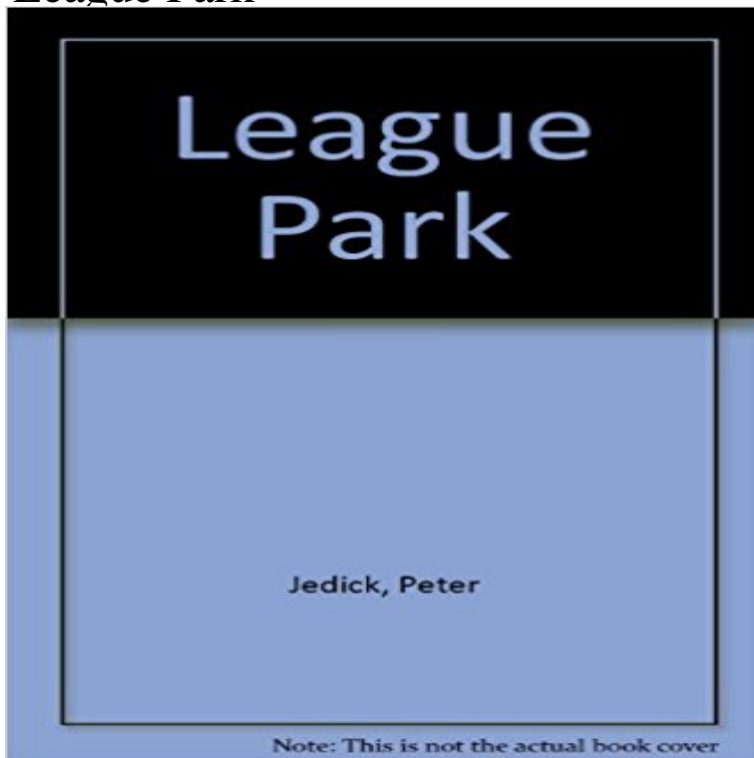


League Park
