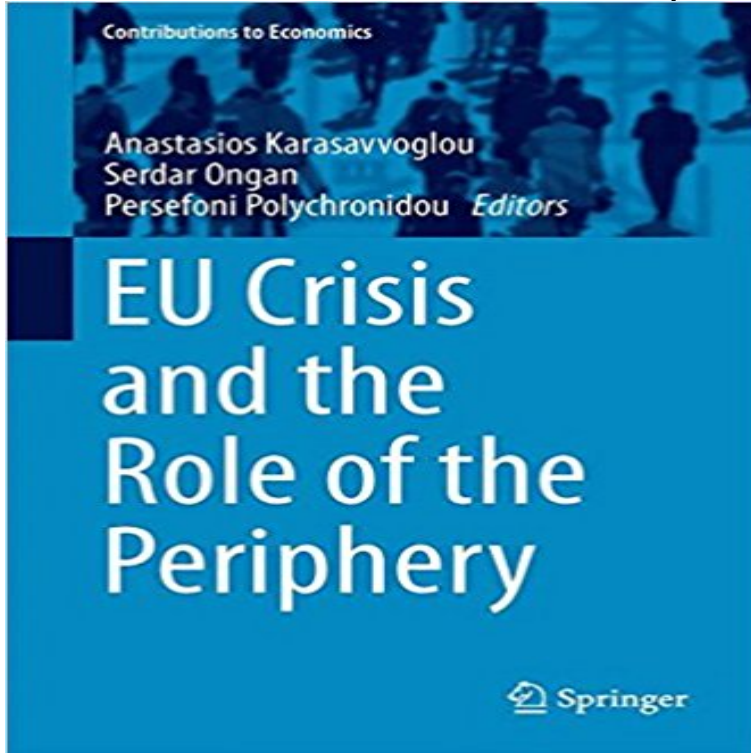


EU Crisis and the Role of the Periphery (Contributions to Economics)

Special topics include the convergence hypothesis, agriculture and growth, Public-Private Partnership in Infrastructure (PPPI), and the labour market.
