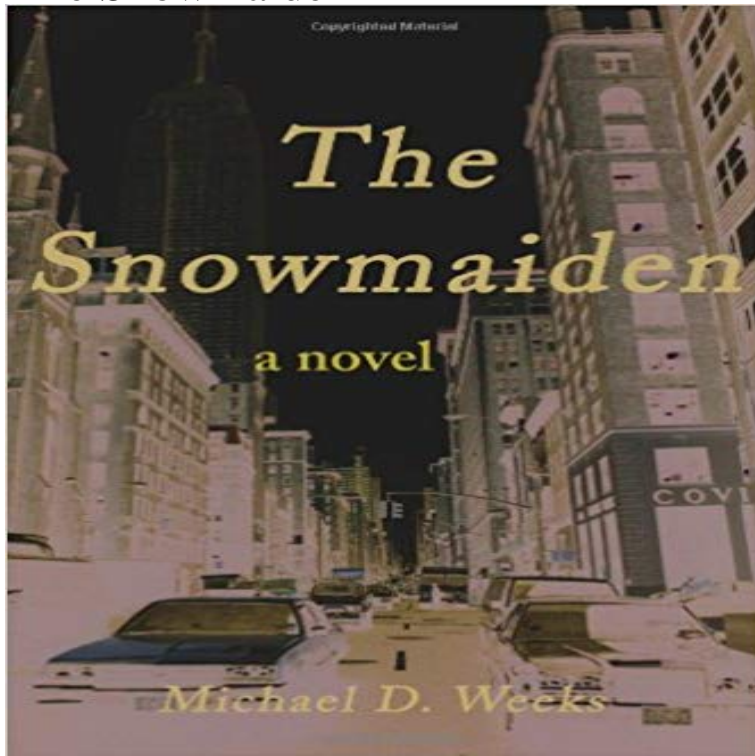


# The Snowmaiden
