

After remaining a couple of hours with them, Parry and his party returned to the ships accompanied by about fifty of the natives of both sexes. They expressed much less surprise and curiosity than might have been expected on their first visit; but they soon had an opportunity of showing their fondness for merriment, for on Captain Lyon ordering his fiddler up on the Heclas deck, they danced with the men for

an hour, and then returned in high glee and good...
