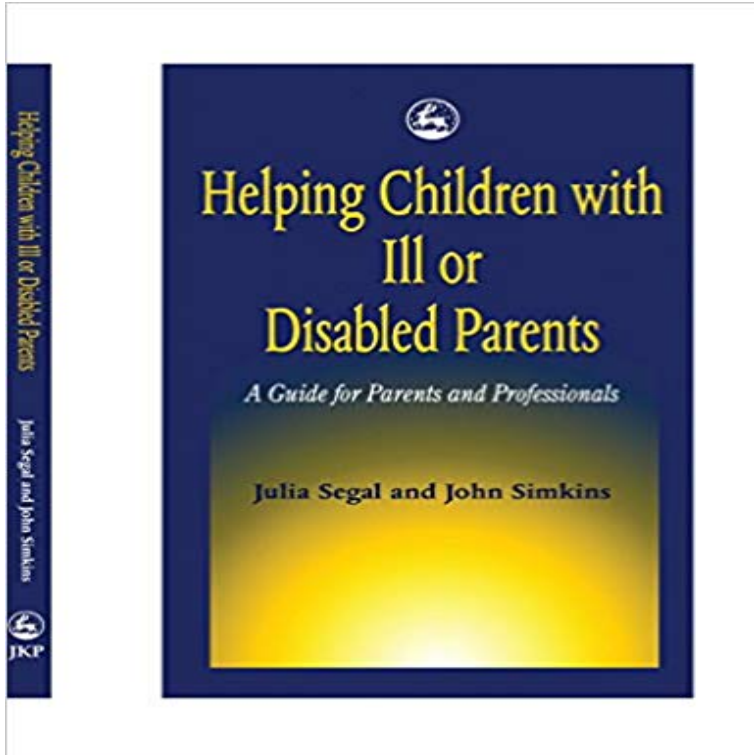


Helping Children with Ill or Disabled Parents: A Guide for Parents and Professionals
