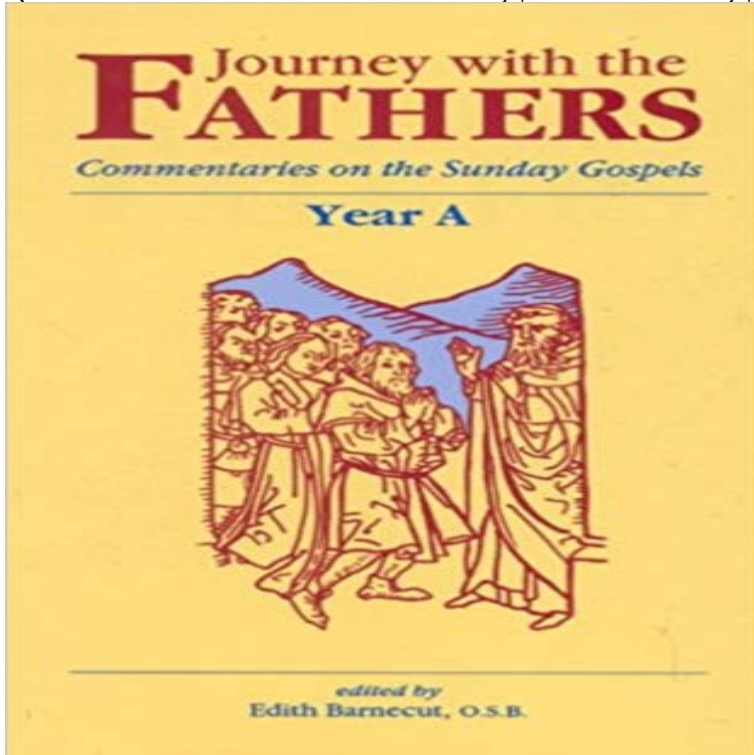


## Journey With the Fathers: Commentaries on the Sunday Gospels, Year A (The Word of God Throughout the Ages. New Testament, No 1)
