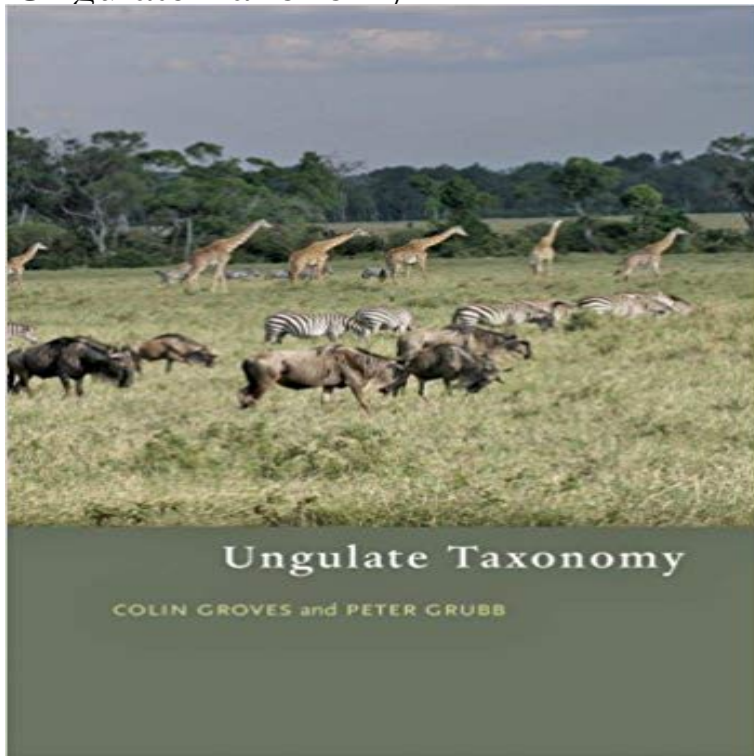


Ungulate Taxonomy
