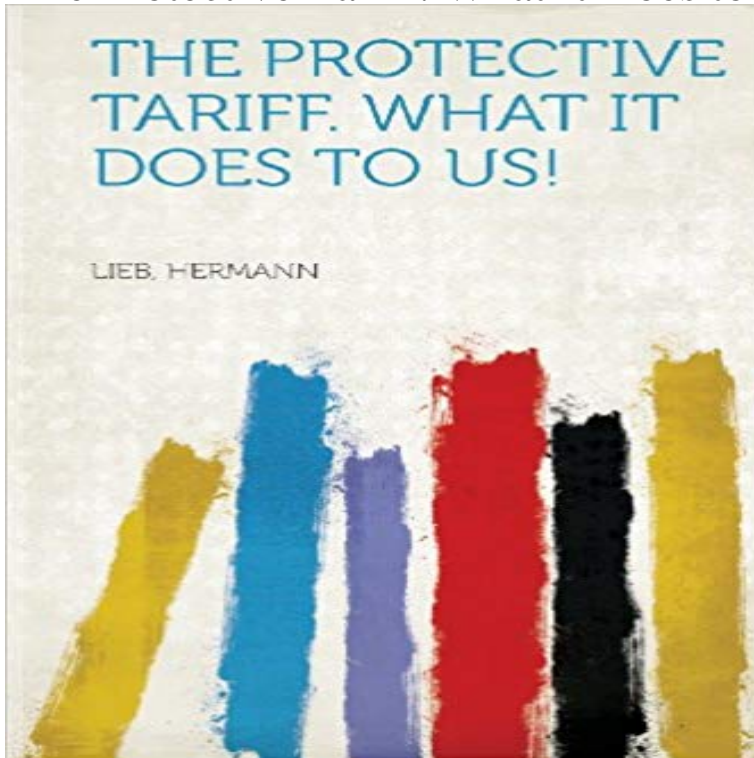


The Protective Tariff. What It Does to Us!
