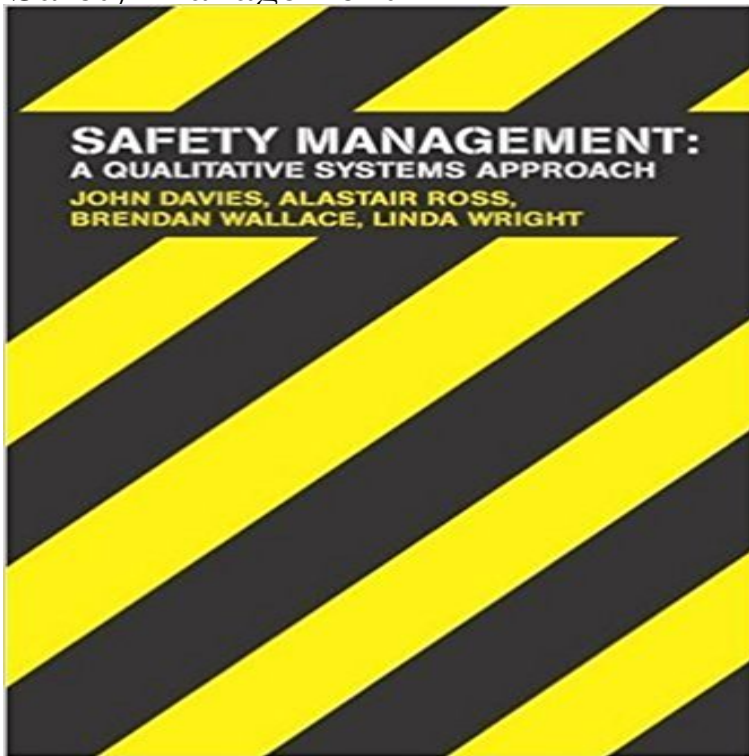


Safety Management
