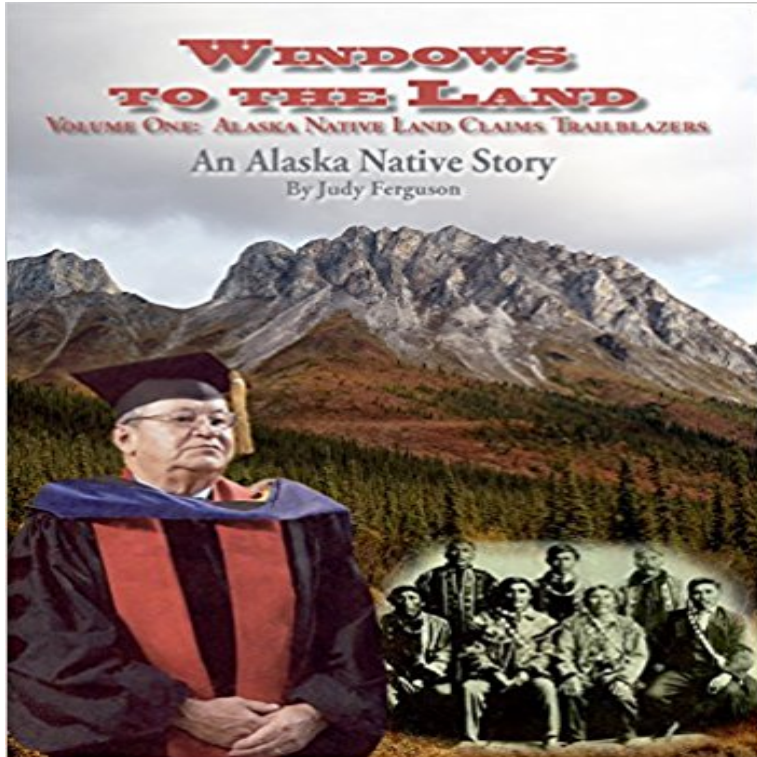


Windows to the Land, An Alaska Native Story Vol. I Alaska Native Land Claims Trailblazers

As windows of the land, Unangan/Aleut, Alutiiq, Sugpiaq, Tsimshian, Tlingit, Haida, Yupik, Cupiaq, Inupiaq, Tanacross, Upper Tanana, Ahtna, Eyak, Denaina, Deg Hitan, and Holikachuk they are the personal face of their cultures, of the Great Land, and of Alaskas evolving story from the Russian colonial period to present, tracking on indigenous land title as well as the breadth of Alaskas history.
